



# Pennsylvania Home Heating Equipment Residential Rebate Program Announcement

Starting April 21, 2010, the Pennsylvania Home Heating Equipment residential rebate program will be available to Pennsylvania residents. Funded by the 2009 American Recovery and Reinvestment Act, the program's limited time-only rebates encourage energy efficient ENERGY STAR-qualified heating equipment purchases and help target energy savings throughout the state.

Rebates are available for the following high efficiency heating equipment that meet or exceed ENERGY STAR efficiency requirements:

Rebates are available on a first-come, first-served basis while funds last starting April 21, 2010. **Reservations are required to receive rebates.** Products that meet Tier 2 efficiency requirements may also be eligible for federal tax rebates (noted in green at left).

*\*Gas source equipment includes natural gas and propane for all product categories.*

## How to participate:

- 1 Inform customers of eligibility requirements**
  - Rebates are available only to Pennsylvania residents who are replacing existing, operational heating equipment.
  - Rebate reservations are required ; once confirmed, rebate applications must be submitted within 30 days or the reservation expires.
  - Contractor installation is required for all products.
  - Purchases must be made within Pennsylvania on or after April 21, 2010, while funds last.
- 2 Identify qualifying heating products**
  - All products in the table above that meet ENERGY STAR efficiency criteria qualify for rebates. Tier 2 requirements are higher than ENERGY STAR baseline and qualify for 2010 federal tax credits.
